



Genpact Breaks Ground for Bhubaneswar SEZ Project

To be built on an area of 12 acres; will offer 500,000 sq ft of office space

INDIA, Orissa, Bhubaneswar (November 21, 2007) – Genpact (NYSE: G), which manages business processes for companies around the world, today broke ground for the upcoming Special Economic Zone (SEZ) it is co-developing along with State Government of Orissa. The Honorable Chief Minister of Orissa, Shri Naveen Patnaik laid the foundation stone for the new facility in the presence of Genpact President & CEO, Pramod Bhasin at a ceremony earlier today. Shri Biswabhusan Harichandan, Minister of Industries, Law & RD; Shri Surjya Narayan Patro, Minister of IT, Energy & Culture and Shri Ajit Kumar Tripathy, IAS, Chief Secretary, Government of Orissa, were among the other dignitaries present at the foundation stone laying ceremony.

Spread over an area of 12.145 acres, the commissioning of this Special Economic Zone (SEZ) facility will happen in three phases between 2009 and 2011. On completion, 500,000 square feet of office space will be available to seat over 4,000 employees for Genpact. The facility is located at Plot No E/42 & E/5/1, Chandaka Industrial Estate, Info City SEZ, Bhubaneswar.

Speaking on the occasion, **Shri Surjya Narayan Patro, Honorable Minister of IT, Energy & Culture**, Govt. of Orissa, said: "It is a matter of great pride for the state of Orissa that a pioneer and a global leader like Genpact has decided to set up operations in the state. This milestone recognizes Orissa's strengths in offering a favorable investment climate, good infrastructure and a young and talented workforce. We are excited about Genpact setting up operations and we hope that this will act as a catalyst for other IT companies to invest in the state."

"We would like to express our gratitude to the State Government of Orissa for the support extended to Genpact in this project, which also marks a critical milestone in our expansion plans in India," said **Pramod Bhasin, President & CEO, Genpact**. "With strong infrastructure, good talent and tremendous government backing, we see Bhubaneswar emerging as an important location for the outsourcing industry."

Over 24,000 Genpact employees are building their careers in India across centers in New Delhi, Gurgaon, Hyderabad, Bangalore, Jaipur and Kolkata. The development of this facility in Bhubaneswar will be the 7th city of operations for Genpact in India.

Genpact has also been allotted a 50 acre plot of land by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh and a 25 acre plot of land by the State Government of Rajasthan for the development of Special Economic Zones (SEZ).

It was recently named the 'Company of the Year' at the Indiatimes BPO Industry Awards held in New Delhi.
