GENPACT SOCIAL IMPACT FELLOWSHIP IN INDIA

GSIF is a unique program in partnership with EdelGive Foundation in which our fellows bring a systemic change in the social sector. The first batch of GSIF fellows conducted projects with leading non-profits and changed the educational ecosystem, thereby improving the learning experience for 70,000+ students



CARE FOR KERE IN INDIA

We partnered with non-profits and the local community to rescue and rejuvenate Sowl Kere, a 48-acre lake in Bangalore. This lake was on the verge of dying but now boasts a quality score of 61.49% (up from 37.24% in 2015)



PLANT A MILLION IN INDIA

In five years, 7,000+ Genpact volunteers have planted 22,000 trees in the Aravalli Biodiversity Park - the largest contribution among all the corporates. This abandoned mining site has transformed into a flourishing city forest.
